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SAFETY ENGINEER

Under the direction of the President, the **Safety Engineer** is responsible for overseeing all safety and health regulation programs and policies as well as accident investigation. This position also oversees the Federal motor carrier safety regulations programs and policies.

Position Responsibilities

- Lead the implementation and continuous improvement of safety activities and risks
- Establish, document, and maintain safety performance standards and specifications
- Develop, maintain, and improve the safety protocols and procedures
- Facilitate the implementation of the Company's Health and Safety policies
- Maintain an in-depth knowledge of all laws surrounding construction safety
- Conducts accident/injury investigations in line with the company policy
- Perform thorough investigation of all accidents/incidents, to ensure that all required policies were followed
- Attend pre-construction meetings and help identify potential safety hazards for the project
- Assist with and lead safety training sessions in the classroom and field
- Performs site inspections/audits

Job Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in Occupational Health and Safety or equivalent years of experience
- At least 5 years' experience as a construction safety manager
- Must have OSHA certifications and OSHA teaching certification
- Must have CPR certification
- Competent in fall protection, confined space, crane operations and excavation/trenching.
- Strong knowledge of underground utilities, large diameter pipe and trenchless technologies.
- Knowledge of medical first aid procedures
- Good organizational, communication and computer skills in a windows-based platform
- Must be able to work independently, be dependable and be a strong team member
- Must read, write and speak English proficiently. Spanish helpful.
